You will receive a NSW Change of Name Certificate.

If you have previously registered a change of name for your child with the NSW Registry of Birth Deaths and Marriages you must return the change of name certificate with your application.

*Qualified witness

The following persons can certify photocopies of documents as being "true and correct copies" of the originals and can also witness your signature.

- Justice of the Peace
- Notary Public
- Legal Practitioner (holding a current Practising Certificate)

Your right to privacy

The NSW Registry of Births Deaths & Marriages administers the Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1995 (NSW). The information required on this form is collected under the provisions of this Act and forms the basis for the registration of a change of name. The change of name register is part of the civil records of NSW and is a permanent historical record. The public does not have access to these records.

The information held by the Registry may be used for statistical purposes and by law enforcement agencies, as well as other uses provided for by law. Such access for approved purposes may be granted to other Registries and certain government agencies (including Passports Office, Department of Immigration and Citizenship, and RTA) and to the authorised non-government agencies.

To protect your privacy, the Registry requires proof of your identity. In line with the Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998, the Registry is collecting this information so that it can determine your eligibility to perform a change of name, to obtain the requested certificate and to prevent fraud.

When you complete this application form, we will assume that you consent to the release of information provided by you, to those agencies who may be able to validate that information in support of your application.

This information may be provided to agencies including (but not limited to) other Registries of Births, Deaths & Marriages, Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFaT), Department of Immigration and Citizenship (DIAC), and motor vehicle or driver licencing authorities. Usually these referrals will be to simply verify the documents or other evidence that you have provided us in making your application for a certificate. If there are discrepancies, we may require you to correct any errors with the issuing agency, before being able to process your application. It is extremely important that all your identity documents are accurate and reflect your correct identity information.

Documents provided as proof of identity may have their authenticity verified through Certificate Validation System (CVS) and the National Document Verification System (DVS). Documents issued by this office may also be verified by other organisations using CVS and/or DVS.





Change of Name For a Child

(Under 18 years)

This application can only be used to register a change of name for a child if:

- The child's birth is registered in NSW, or
- They were born overseas and have been resident in NSW for at least 3 consecutive years immediately preceding the date of application.
- This birth is not registered in NSW and a protection order has been made for the child and/or their parents from domestic violence.

How to complete this application

Please read all instructions carefully. All sections of this form must be completed. Please use blue or black ink and BLOCK letters to complete this form. All corrections must be initialled. Do not use white out.

If you have changed your child's name with any Registry office in Australia in the last 12 months or have registered three (3) previous changes of name within Australia, your application can only be approved with the consent of the Registrar upon consideration of your reason for the change. This does not affect an Australian or New Zealand court order.

1. This application includes two (2) forms (Statutory Declaration and Payment Details) which must be completed and given to the Registry with the appropriate identification and fee.
2. All sections must be completed to ensure your application can be processed quickly. A checklist is provided to assist you. Incomplete applications will experience a delay and may be returned to you or refused.
3. Each parent and child must provide identification (see identification requirements on Page 5). Please provide at least three (3) forms of identification with your application (see Identification categories). A qualified witness* must certify photocopies of identification documents as being "true and correct copies" (see page 6).
4. Photo identification must be provided.
5. If your child is 12 years of age or older, they must consent to the changed name, unless there is exceptional circumstances.
6. It is a requirement of the applicant to inform the Registrar if their child has a criminal record.
7. The consent of BOTH parents (recorded on the child's birth certificate) is required to change a child's name. Where details of the father do not appear on the birth certificate, then only the mother's consent is required.
8. If both parents appear on the birth certificate, they are both required to provide consent. In cases where one parent refuses or their whereabouts are unknown, an Order to change the child's name issued by an Australian court will be accepted.
9. Where a child's parents are deceased, cannot be found or for some other reason cannot exercise their parental responsibilities in relation to the child, the person allocated parental responsibility by the court may apply to register a change of name for the child.
10. If your child's name has changed, please record ALL names on the Statutory Declaration form. There are penalties in place if you knowingly provide incorrect information and your application may be refused.
11. Write your present residential address on the Statutory Declaration form. A post office box is not acceptable. You can record your postal address on the Payment Details form.
12. Ensure your signature on the Statutory Declaration form is witnessed by a qualified witness*. The qualified witness must complete their name, address and daytime telephone number.
13. The fee for registering a Change of Name includes either a Change of Name Certificate or a Birth Certificate.
14. A processing fee applies if you decide not to proceed with the application, or are unable to complete the process. Only the certificate fee will be refunded in these circumstances.
15. The Registry will NOT ACCEPT faxed applications OR faxed identification documents.
16. Overseas documents must be translated into English by an accredited translator.

Section 57 – False representation: A person who makes a representation in an application, notice or document under this Act or in response to a notice under section 44 of this Act (Registrar's powers of inquiry), knowing the representation to be false or misleading in a material particular, is guilty of an offence.

Maximum penalty: 100 penalty units or 2 years imprisonment, or both.

- **You must establish proof of the child’s original name and all other names used by the child.**

To protect your privacy, the Registry requires proof of your identity.

Identification – Parent/person with parental responsibility

Each parent/person with parental responsibility must provide at least three (3) forms of identification, one of each from Categories 1, 2, 3 and/or 4.

- At least one (1) form of identification must be from Category 1 and must contain your full name, date of birth and place of birth. If your Category 1 document does not contain your place of birth, you must also provide a passport (current or expired) or a full birth certificate containing this information.
- The other forms of identification (at least two) must be provided from Category 2 and/or Category 3.
- If your current residential address is not included on your Category 2 or 3 document you must provide a further document from Category 4.
- If your child’s birth was registered overseas you must provide a document from Category 4 as evidence of your NSW residency

You must also provide at least two (2) other forms of identification **one each** from Categories 2 and 3.
