I understand the enormous workload the transition to power must entail. I appreciate you reading this letter.

I wrote to you on the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2010 regarding the practice of non-medically indicated circumcision of infant males. The letter also questioned the issue of parental consent for such procedures and outlined my personal experience.

You kindly replied to my letter on the 24<sup>th</sup> of November and indicated that you had "shared my concerns" with Mr Greg Smith MP, the then Shadow Attorney General.

On the 9<sup>th</sup> of December 2010 I sent you a further letter which had as an attachment a letter I had written to The Prime Minister on the subject.

Again, I understand the enormity of the task of transitioning to Government and beginning to action the long list of overdue priorities. Would you please assure me, however, that in due course I will be provided with the government's stance regarding the various issues that I have raised regarding non-medically indicated circumcision of infant males.
