Good morning Ms Pandolsini,

In August 2010 my then six week old son was circumcised without medical need and without my consent.

I was advised to ring PIAC by Mr Paul Mason. Mr Mason is the former Tasmanian Commissioner for Children and is now a barrister in Hobart.

On the 5th of February I rang PIAC and spoke to Ketki.

I followed up the matter on the 19th of February, again speaking with Ketki. She advised me that the matter had been referred to yourself and was not a matter that PIAC would pursue.

The domain www.MyCircumcisionDisgrace.org chronicles my efforts to elicit change in this area.

My first and seemingly impossible aim is to eliminate or at least further marginalise the practice of non-medically indicated infant male circumcision.

My second aim, one which I remain ABSOLUTELY DETERMINED to achieve, is the overhaul of the consent regime that currently allows for an infant to be subjected to non-medically indicated circumcision with the consent of only one parent, in potential deference to the views of the other parent.

So as PIAC may be accurately represented on my website, would you please pen a brief letter confirming PIAC's stance.
